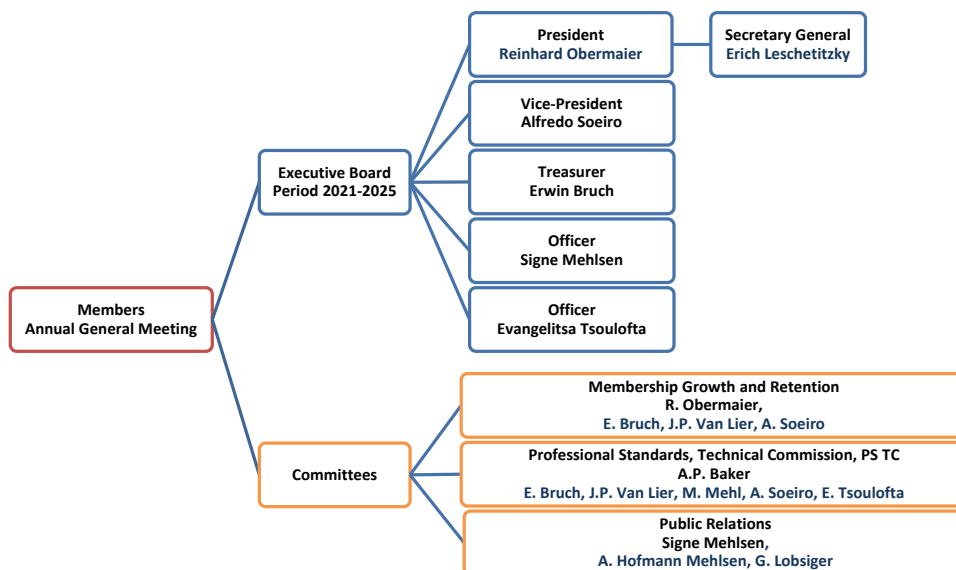

SHCC – The Mandate

Safety and Health Construction Coordination (SHCC)
Initiate and accompany measures to coordinate safety and health (of employees) and to ensure their implementation

- Coordination in planning (planning phase)
 - Initiating and coordinating measures so that
 - Information on structure and design for safe working
 - general principles of prevention and safety
 - Setup of the safety and health plan
 - Prior notice
- Coordination in execution (construction phase)
 - Safety and health plan
 - Publication / Distribution
 - Implementation
 - Update
 - Establishment of a health and safety regimes and monitoring
 - Information on mutual risks and planned protective measures
 - Including the adaption of changes
 - Initiating OSH control measures
 - Implementation of the Follow-up of deviations
 - Safe, subsequent work on the structure **1st Report and consulting during PLANNING**
 Initiate and assemble the health and safety documentation (the File).
