The event was opened by **Mr. William Cockburn Salazar**, Executive Director of EU-OSHA, who highlighted that: "Digital innovation must serve workers—not replace their well-being."

Keynote speakers included:

- Ms. Li Andersson, Chair of the Committee on Employment & Social Affairs at the European Parliament, highlighted the need to reduce workplace accidents and fatalities through enhanced protection.
- **Mr. Mario Nava**, Director General for Employment, Social Affairs & Inclusion at the European Commission, who highlighted forthcoming EU directives aimed at improving working conditions and ensuring digital safety.
- **Dr. Natalie Lotzmann**, Global Head of Health, Safety & Wellbeing at SAP, who presented a corporate perspective on integrating health and dignity into digital work environments.



The event featured two engaging parallel workshops:

- Workshop 1: Practical Examples of Al Applications in OSH real-world tech driving proactive safety.
- Workshop 2: Al in the Workplace: Legal Foundations & Ethical Considerations ensuring fairness, transparency, and rights in an Al-driven future.

The core message of the event was clear: "A safe and healthy digital workplace is possible—if we build it together."
